The National Fraternal Order of Police announced the launch of the National PhotoAlert™ network, the nation's first comprehensive data and photographic system designed to help improve the speed of recovery of missing children.

"In a life-threatening child abduction, we know that the first three hours are critical to safely returning a child," said Chuck Canterbury, president of the National Fraternal Order of Police. "We believe PhotoAlert is an important tool that will accelerate law enforcement's efforts to recover missing children."
