SCHOLARSHIP RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations governing the scholarship awarded annually by the Kenton County Fraternal Order of Police Associates are being set forth to ensure the proper utilization of the funds awarded, as well as fairness and equality in the awarding of the scholarship.

- I. The applicant must be:
 - A. The son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter, stepson or stepdaughter of an active member of the Kenton County Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #20, retired, on medical disability or deceased who is or was in good standing of the Kenton County Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #20.
 - B. A graduating senior of an accredited high school, OR
 - C. An undergraduate student of an accredited college.
- II. Each applicant must complete an application form and submit it along with a transcript of the last 3 ½ years of high school grades or college transcript of courses completed. **Applications must be submitted to the Associates Lodge by the second Thursday of June.** No application shall be considered without the current grade transcript and one-page essay.
- III.

The grade transcripts will be submitted to an impartial scholarship committee comprised of members of the Kenton County Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #20 Associate Lodge. All grades will be converted into a numerical score and averaged for the 3 ½ years. The grade averages will be listed in order of descending scores. The scholarship will be awarded to the candidate based on grade averages, financial need, and essay on his/her objectives.
- IV.

The funds will be administered in the following manner:

 - A. The funds may be used to attend any accredited college or university..
 - B. The funds may be used for tuition, books, and lab fees. The funds may be used for housing fees only after tuition, books, and lab fees are paid. No part of the funds may be used for recreation in any manner.
 - C. Each person applying will receive a letter informing him/her of the final outcome of the selection process.
